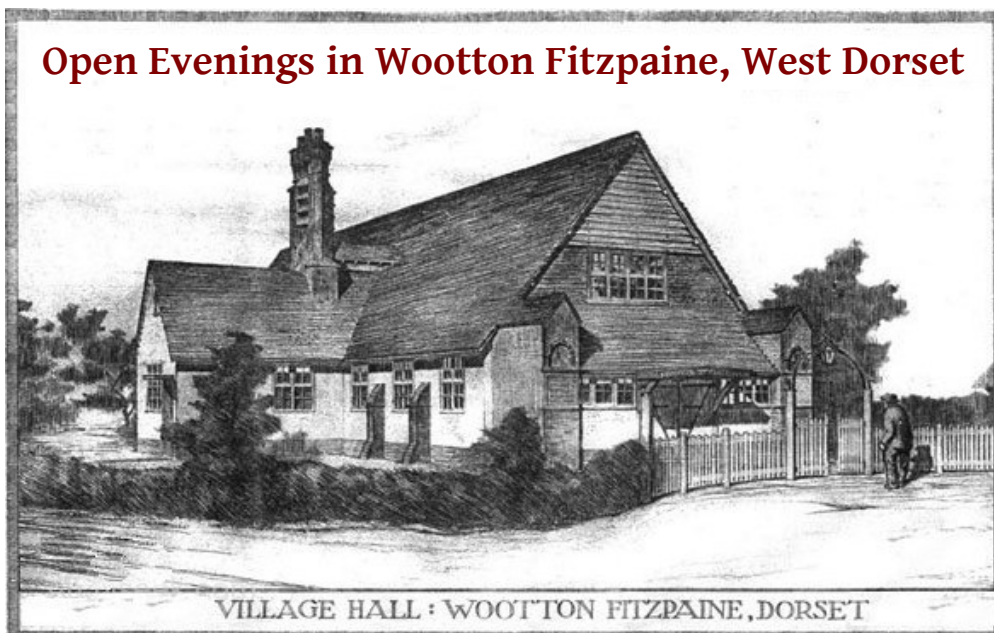


The Move into Life Project Group
